
Evening Session: Session by Shraddhawan Project coordinator

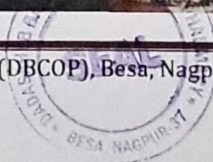

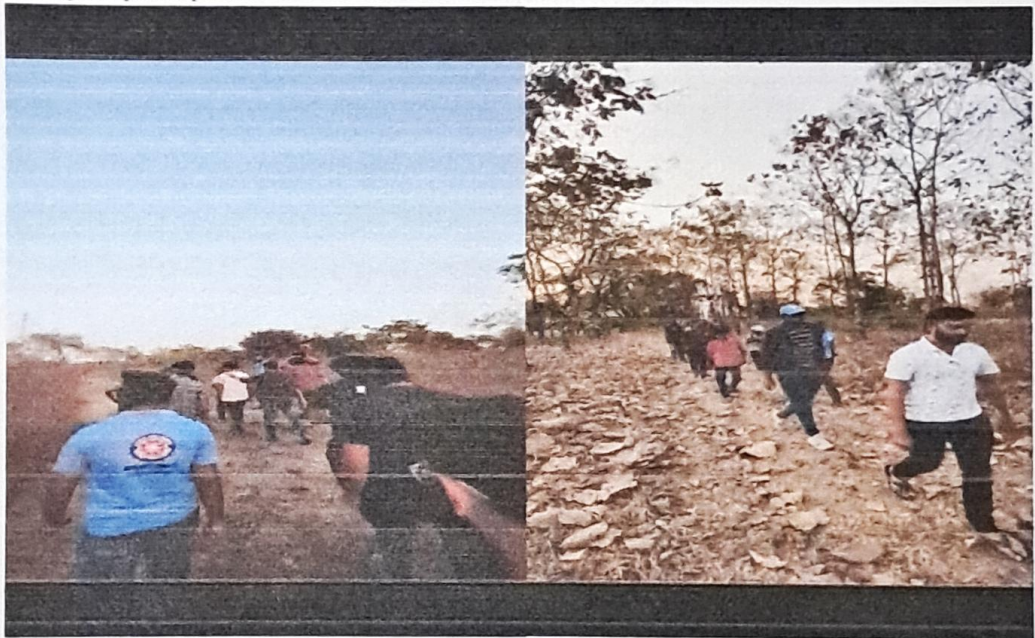
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
Day – 6 - 21/02/2026

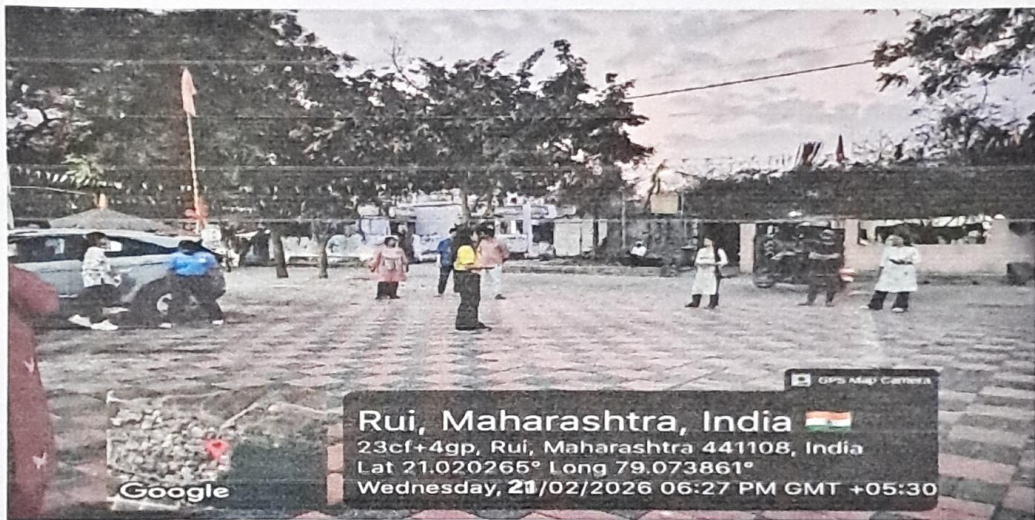


**Summary of NSS Special Camp 2025-26






